

# Skymet forecasts a normal monsoon for 2025, with 103% of the long-period average rainfall

- Skymet projects a 'normal' southwest monsoon for 2025, with cumulative rainfall expected to be 103% of the Long Period Average (LPA).
- There is an 80% chance that monsoon rains will be in the range of 'excess' to 'normal' this season.

Sluggish Start is expected for Monsoon 2025 with rainfall expected to pick up in the second half, boosting **crop prospects** and **water reservoirs**.

Estimated monthly distribution relative to the LPA:

- June: 96%
- July: 102%
- August: 108%
- September: 104%

The country's official weather forecaster India Meteorological Department (IMD) is expected to release the first prediction for the monsoon season soon.
